
Dear Representative Berman:

Thank you for your June 18, 2012 letter requesting that "Taiwan" replace "China (Taiwan)" on U.S. Customs and Border Protection's (CBP) Form I-94 (nonimmigrant arrival-departure form) and "Taiwan, Province of China" in the Global Entry Program.

Thank you for bringing this issue to our attention. CBP has looked into and corrected this matter. Henceforth, persons presenting Taiwanese passports will have their country of citizenship listed and recorded as "Taiwan" on their respective Form I-94 and the Global Entry Program application process will refer to "Taiwan."
